And so we begin! Thank you everyone who has stepped forward to help run our Sunday School program this year. We have filled the minimum requirement for teachers this year, and for that we are thankful. Thank you also to our helpers and prayer partners as those needs have been successfully filled. We are ready to go!

We have approximately 120 children in our Sunday School program this year, wow! There are 22 teachers sharing 10 classes, 8 helpers, 17 prayer partners, 7 supply teachers/helpers, and four of our existing teachers are also serving on the executive committee. Many hands makes light work and know that you are all so appreciated for your humble service.

This morning marks our very first teaching Sunday — the classes will be dismissed individually as they are called out. Parents, please help your little ones in Beginners and Kindergarten to find their way as needed. As well, Grade 1 and younger will not be dismissed until a parent has picked them up immediately following the service, so please come promptly to collect your children. We have had to combine our Grade 4, 5, and 6 classes into two groups — these grades will be dismissed to the Sunset room to start this morning, where they will then be divided into their two respective classes. Signs are posted in the hallways downstairs to point you in the direction of the classes, and there is a map on the Sunday School bulletin board as well.

We covet your prayers as we begin another year in this "core ministry" as I like to call it. Seeds of faith are being planted, and Biblical truths are being taught. We are thankful for our volunteers, and your prayers as well.
